Child Highlight: Nalwadda Betty

Betty is a girl of 15 years. She is in Primary 6 at Calvary Chapel Christian School and she was elected as the Head Girl of the school this year, equivalent to Student Body President.

She lost both of her parents to HIV/AIDS and she never got a chance to experience true parental love. Like many other unfortunate orphans, Betty has moved from place to place looking for a place to call home. Throughout her life she has been abused in so many unspeakable ways. She has grown up in fear of the future and those that surround her because of her past. Just prior to joining Asifiwe Child Care, she was forced to

sell her body in order to buy food and clothes for herself. She was encouraged to do so by the people she was staying with because they would not provide for her.

But she has not given up on herself. She has found that God loves her and that there is hope for the future. As she has joined the Asifiwe family, we have seen her change into a joyful and friendly girl with hope for the future. She wants to become a doctor when she grows up.

Pallisa Project Update: Literacy Program

Thank you for your prayers! We know you have been praying because we have seen the Lord working in great ways. In June, we began our first literacy class in the village of Nyakoi, Pallisa. We have one class of 25 orphaned children. We were able to begin this class through our child sponsorship program. Not all of the children in the program have sponsors, but we were able to begin through the few sponsors that are helping us. We pray the Lord will add

more so we can continue to teach these children to read and write so they will be prepared for primary school. Many orphaned children are unable to attend school because no one is able or willing to pay for their tuition. Thus, several of the students in our literacy class are of age for primary school, but they don't know how to read or write and are unable to begin primary one without those

skills.

We are so happy to begin this Literacy program and see how the Lord can transform the lives of these children through the daily Bible lessons, healthy food, and education. Thank you so much for everyone who is involved in this program!


